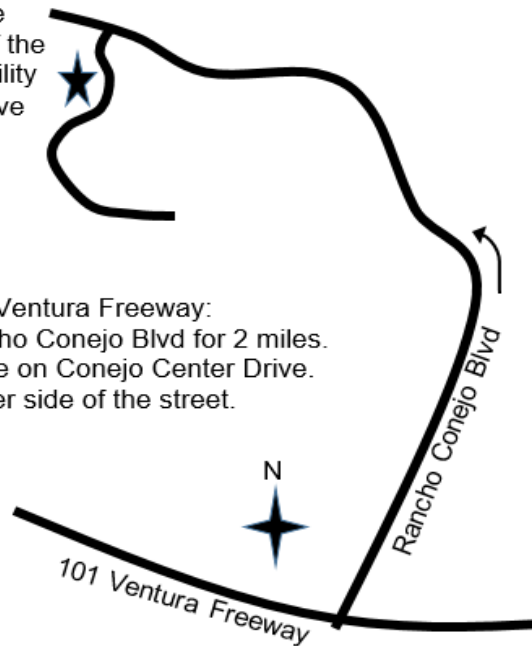

Rain date October 22nd

Registration is in the parking lot just south of the Hazardous Waste Facility on Conejo Center Drive

From 101 Ventura Freeway:
Drive north on Rancho Conejo Blvd for 2 miles.
Left (south) 0.2 mile on Conejo Center Drive.
Park on either side of the street.



7:30 a.m. Meet at parking lot on Conejo Center Drive, just beyond the Household Hazardous Waste Facility
Check-in at the registration table
Complete and sign a Liability Release form
Receive your breakfast bag

8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Trail Work
Orientation and safety instructions
Tools distributed
Trail Crew Leaders will direct you to your work site

12:00 - 2:00 p.m. Volunteers will be treated to a Thank You Lunch. Door prizes will be awarded to some lucky Trail Work Day participants.
Grand Prize is a new mountain bike!
(Winners must be present at the drawing)

Water will be available at the sign-in area.

Be sure to bring a water bottle and fill up before going to your work site.

Toilets will be available at the registration area, and not at the work sites.

Please use the facilities before proceeding to your project area.

Wear protective clothing & eyewear, sturdy shoes, gloves, hat and sunscreen. Do not bring your own tools - tools will be provided.

No experience is necessary. Instructions on trail building, and the safe and proper use of tools/equipment will be given.

Beware of poison oak, ticks and rattlesnakes. Check with a ranger or trail crew leader if you need assistance with identification.

Follow the directions of the park rangers and trail crew leaders at all times. They are trained for trail projects.

If you or someone in your work group needs medical attention, contact a ranger or your trail crew leader.
